

TWO SORT CO-MINGLED RECYCLING PREPARATION

Proper Preparation is the Key to Successful Recycling.

Your Efforts are Important and Appreciated!

CONTAINER #1: MIXED PAPER, CANS, ALUMINUM & PLASTIC BOTTLES

Corrugated Cardboard: Flatten all boxes. Also okay: brown paper sacks. *NO waxed boxes.*

Newspaper, magazines and catalogs: *NO plastic bags/wrappers.*

Mixed Office Paper: All writing & printing paper generated in an office, as well as envelopes, file folders and carbonless forms. *NO ream wrappers.*

Scrap Paper: Cereal boxes, paper egg cartons, wrapping paper, poster board. *NO paper towels, plastic or wax coated papers, foil, food contaminated paper, plastic.*

Paper Milk Cartons & Drink Boxes: Rinse & Flatten.

Steel (Tin) Cans: Rinse, remove both ends, flatten. Remove paper labels.

Also Okay: Aluminum cans, foil, pie plates (washed and clean), small pieces of scrap metal (free of attached plastic, rubber, etc.) and aerosol cans (must be empty, remove plastic lids).

Plastic: Bottles with neck or screw-on lid and margarine or yogurt-type tub (all 6 oz. or larger with the lids removed and discarded), rigid plant pots (4 inches or more), buckets that are 5 gallons or smaller. *NO bags, lids, deli food containers, blisterpak, film/plastic wrap or packaging and NO Styrofoam.*

CONTAINER #2: GLASS

Glass Bottles & Jars: Rinse. Do Not Break. All colors okay. *DO NOT include drinking glasses, window glass, pyrex, light bulbs or ceramics.*
